



GRHA 2010 Best Practices Sample Survey

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Program: Infant and Child Wellbeing Partnership

Type: Access/Coverage

What is it: The Best County Infant and Child Wellbeing Partnership serves pre-natal patients and their children from pregnancy through age 10. Mothers and children work with a patient manager to ensure that routine health exams and vaccinations are completed. Clients learn about nutrition, educational services, childcare services, and workforce training. This program provides a medical home for families who would not have access to a primary care physician.

Who is it for: Patients living in Best County and contiguous counties are eligible for program services

Why do you do this: Best County and surrounding areas have a high rate of uninsured adults and children who do not have access to regular healthcare services.

Impact: Thirty percent of the residents in the service area are uninsured. Many pregnant women have no access to pre-natal care, which ICWP provides. The rate of low birth-weight babies among clients has been reduced to 1 percent. Non-emergent visits to the local hospital ED have been reduced by 75 percent among program clients.
